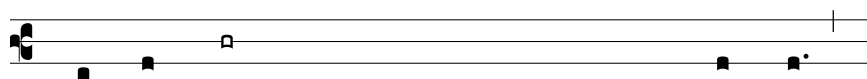
1. Sacrifice or offering you wished *not*, but ears open



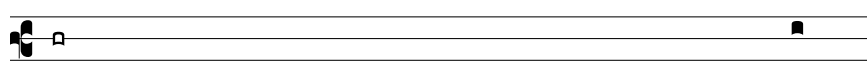
to obedience you *gave* me. Holocausts or sin-



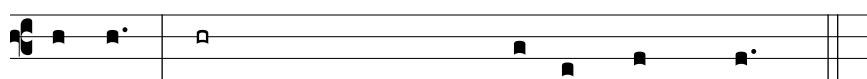
offerings you sought not; then said I, "*Be*-hold I come." R<sub>z</sub>.



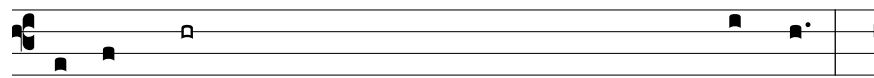
2. "In the written scroll it is prescribed *for* me.



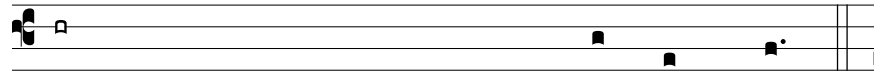
To do your will, O my God, is *my*



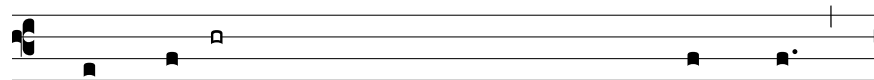
delight, and your law is *with*-in my heart!" R<sub>z</sub>.



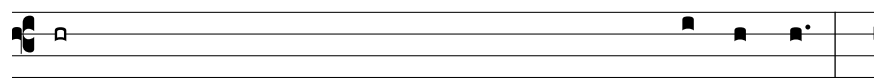
3. I announced your justice in the vast as-*sem*-bly;



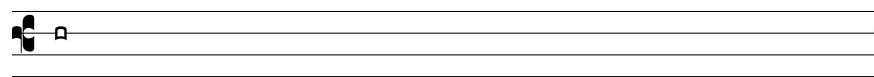
I did not restrain my lips, as you, O LORD, know. *R*ꝫ.



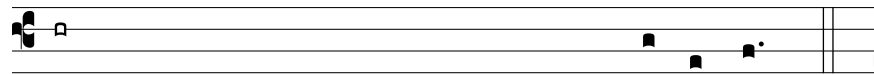
4. Your justice I kept not hid within *my* heart;
