
1. Bless the LORD, O my *soul!* O LORD, my








2. You fixed the earth upon its *foun-da-tion*, not to be




moved *for-ev-er*; with the ocean, as with a garment,

3. You send forth springs into the watercourses




that wind among the *moun-tains*. Beside them the




birds of heaven dwell; from among the branches they




*send* forth their song. Ṙ.




4. You water the mountains from your *pal-ace*;




the earth is replete with the fruit of *your* works.




You raise grass for the cattle, and vegetation



In wisdom you have *wrought* them all — the earth is




full of your creatures. Bless the LORD, O my soul! R̄.
