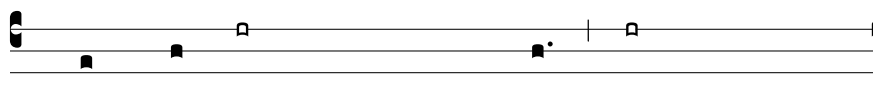
2. Hear, O LORD, the sound of my *call*; have pity on



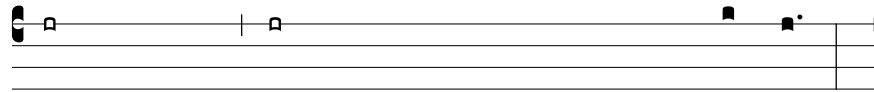
me, and *an*-swer me. Of you my heart speaks; *you*



my glance seeks. R̄.



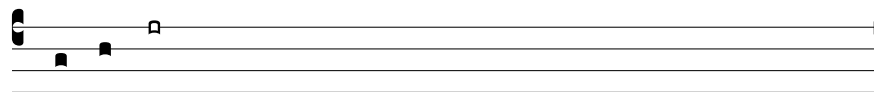
3. Your presence, O LORD, I *seek*. Hide not your



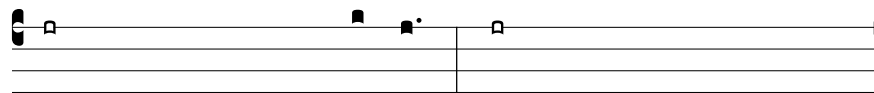
face from me; do not in anger repel your *ser-vant*.



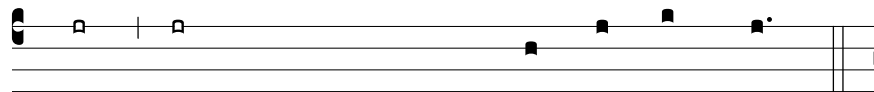
You are my helper: *cast* me not off. Ṙ.
