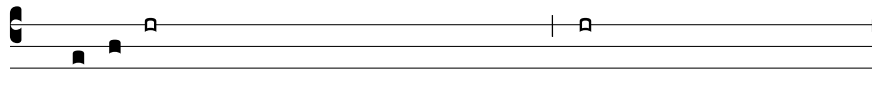
1. I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall



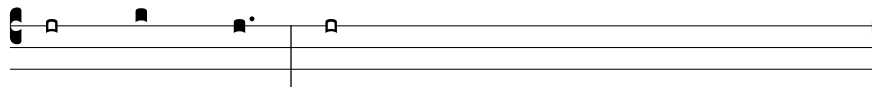
be ever in *my* mouth. Let my soul glory in



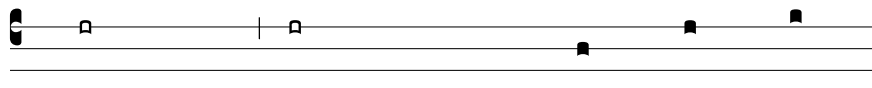
the LORD; the lowly will *hear* me and be glad. R̄.



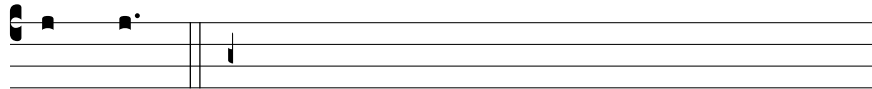
2. Glorify the LORD with me, let us together



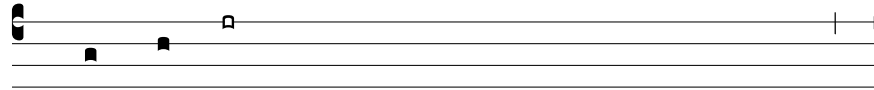
extol *his* name. I sought the Lord, and he



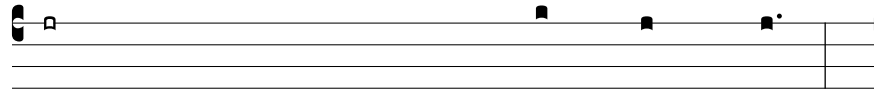
answered me and delivered *me* from all



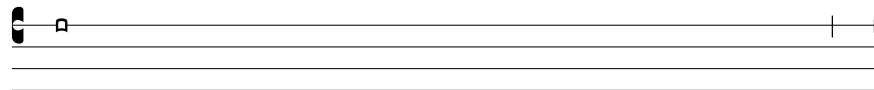
my fears. R̄.



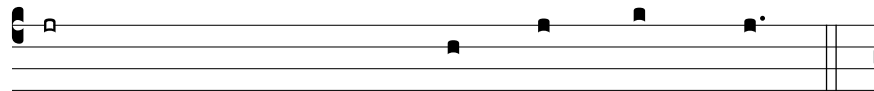
3. Look to him that you may be radiant with joy,
