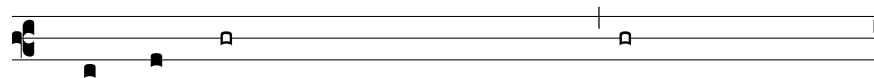
lasts but a moment; a lifetime, his good will.



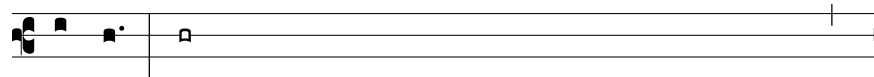
At nightfall, weeping enters in, but with the dawn,
