



Praise to you, Lord Je-sus Christ, King of end-less glo-ry.

### Verse for Ash Wednesday




If to-day you hear *his* voice, hard-*en* not your hearts.   ℞

### Verse for the First Sunday of Lent




One does not live on bread *a-lone*, but on every word that comes forth from *the* mouth of God.   ℞

### Verse for the Second Sunday of Lent




From the shining cloud the Father's voice *is* heard: This is my belo-*ved* Son, hear him.   ℞

### Verse for the Third Sunday of Lent




Re-pent, says *the* Lord; the kingdom of heav-*en* is at hand.   ℞

### Verse for the Fourth Sunday of Lent




I will get up and go to the Father and *say* to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and





### Verse for the Fifth Sunday of Lent



### Verse for Palm Sunday





### Verse for Holy Thursday


