For Dioceses celebrating the Ascension on Thursday






On the first day of March will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of

you will cel-eb-rate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Je-




sus Christ. On the twenty fifth day of May will be the Ascension of our




Lord Je- sus Christ. On the fourth day of June the feast of Pen- tecost.

of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ev-er and ev-er. Amen.


