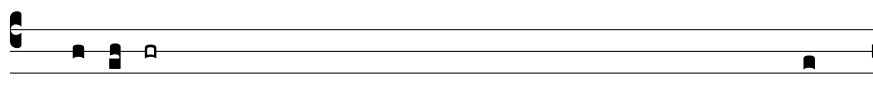
1. I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall



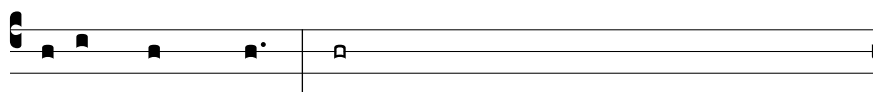
be *ev-er* in my mouth. Let my soul glory in



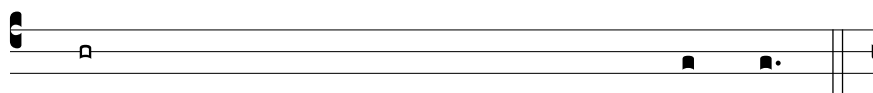
the LORD; the lowly will hear me and *be* glad. R̄.



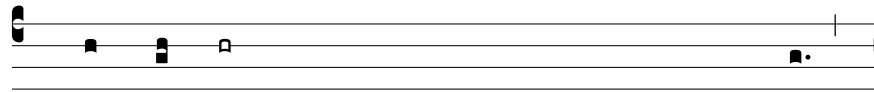
2. Glori-fy the LORD with me, let us togeth-*er*



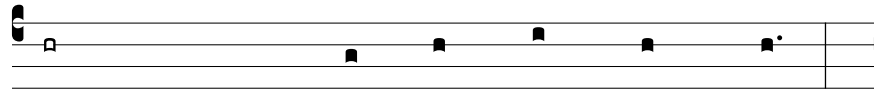
extol his name. I sought the LORD, and he



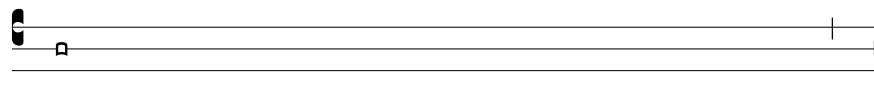
answered me and delivered me from all *my* fears. R̄.



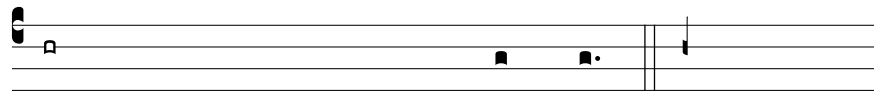
3. Look to him that you may be radiant with *joy*,



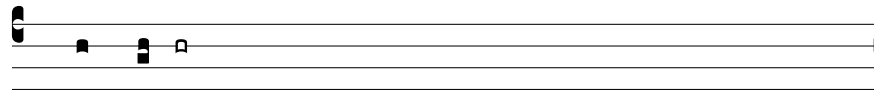
and your faces *may* not blush with shame.



When the poor one called out, the LORD heard,



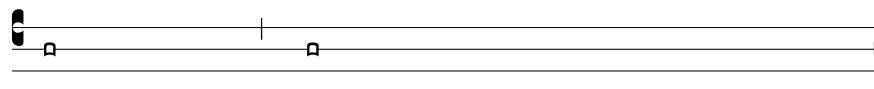
and from all his distress he *saved* him. *R.*



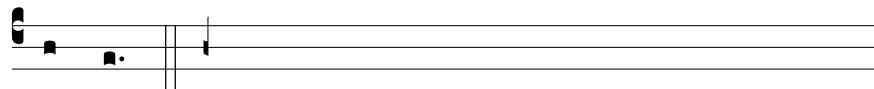
4. The angel of the LORD encamps around those who
