1. God is our refuge and our *strength*, an ever-present

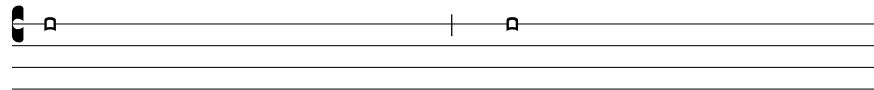
help in *dis-tress*. Therefore, we fear not, though the

earth be shaken and mountains plunge into the *depths*

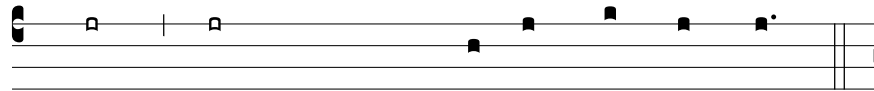

city of *God*, the holy dwelling of the *Most High*.



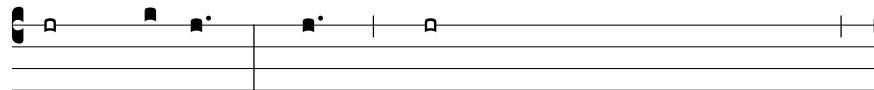
God is in its midst; it shall not be



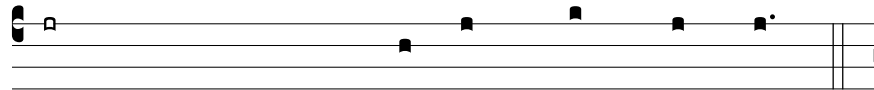
disturbed; God will help it *at* the break of dawn. R̄.
