
3. According to the decree for Israel, to give thanks to



the name of *the* LORD. In it are set up judgment




seats, seats for the *house* of David. Ṙ.




4. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem! May those




who love you *pro-sper!* May peace be within




your walls, prosperity *in* your buildings. Ṙ.
