
2. Once again, O LORD of hosts, look down

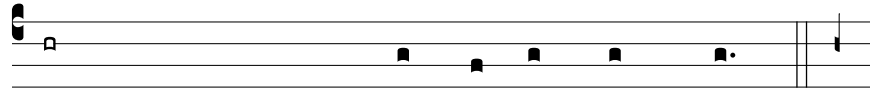


from *heav*-en, and see; take care of this vine,

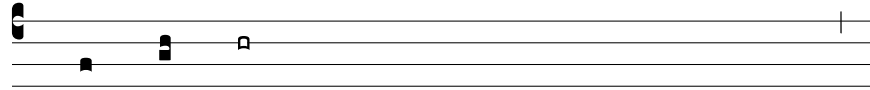

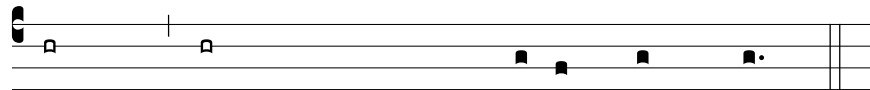
3. May your help be with the man of your right hand,
