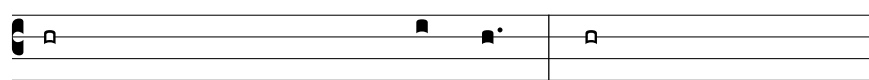

2. Kindness and truth *shall* meet; justice and *peace*

shall kiss. Truth shall spring out of the earth, and



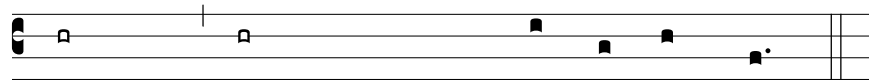
justice shall look *down* from heaven. R̄.
