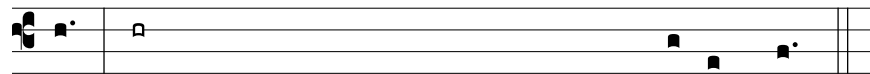
relieve me when I am in *dis-tress*; have pity on me,



and hear my prayer! *R.*



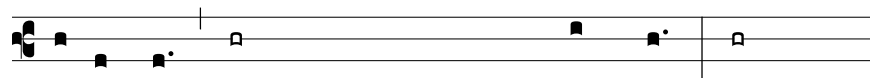
2. Know that the LORD does wonders for his *faith-ful*



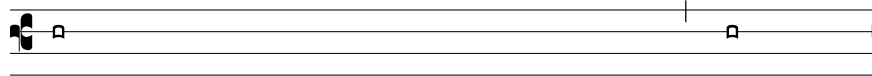
one; the LORD will hear me when I call *up-on* him. *R.*



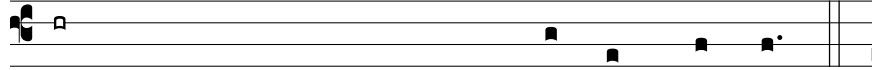
3. O LORD, let the light of your countenance shine
