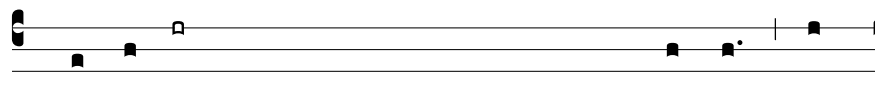
1. Shout joyfully to God, all the earth, sing praise to



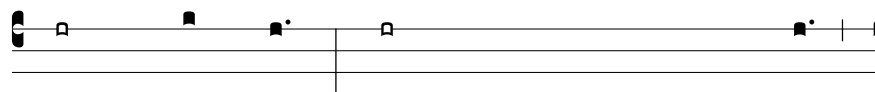
