





saving power.

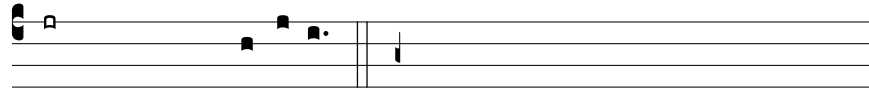


1. Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has *done*

him, his *ho-ly* arm. R̄.

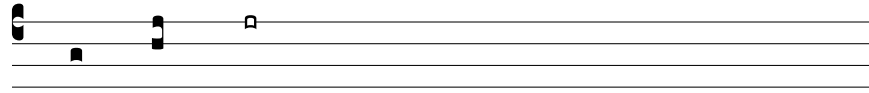


2. The LORD has made his salvation *known*: in the sight

remembered his kindness and his faithfulness toward

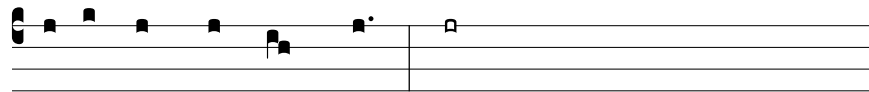




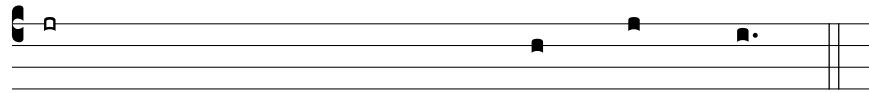
the house of *Is*-rael. Ṙ.
