"He relied on the LORD; let him deliver him,

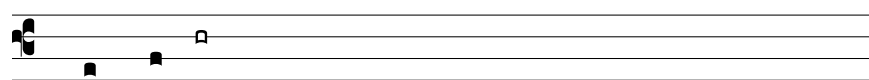

2. Indeed, many dogs surround me, a pack of evildoers

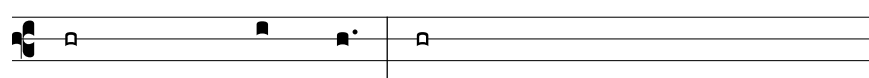
  
closes in *up-on* me; they have pierced my hands



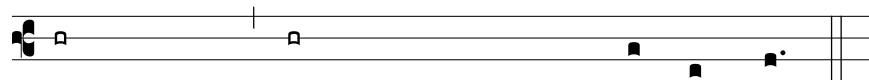
and my feet; I can *count* all my bones. Ṙ.



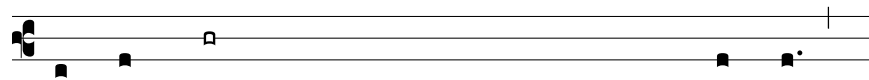
3. They divide my garments among them, and for my



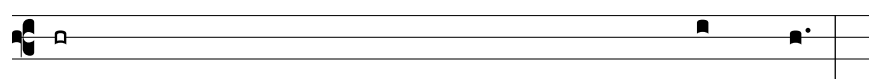
vesture they *cast* lots. But you, O LORD, be not



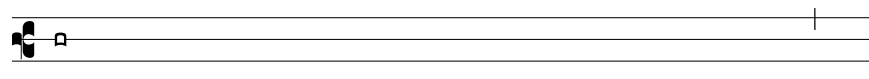
far from me; O my help, hasten *to* aid me. Ṙ.



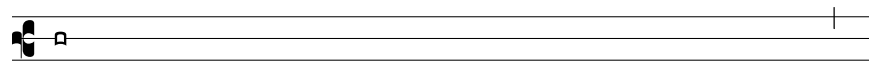
4. I will proclaim your name to my *breth*-ren;



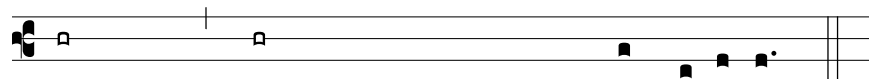
in the midst of the assembly I will *praise* you:
