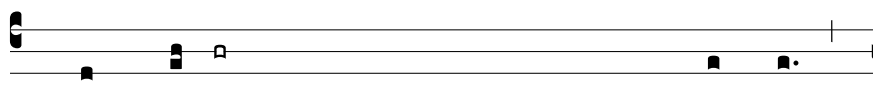

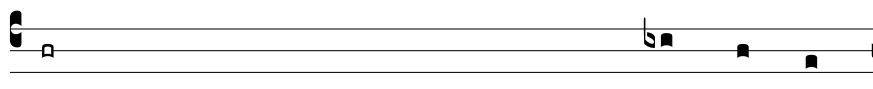

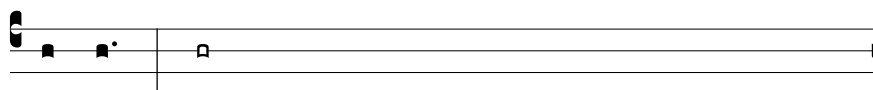

1. Have mercy on me, O God, in your *good-ness*;



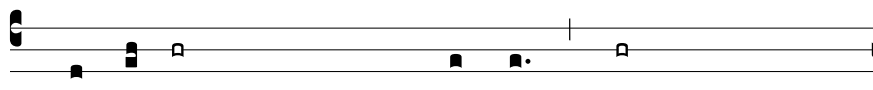
