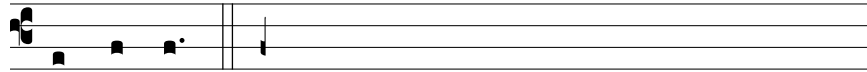


1. Upright is the word of the LORD, and all his

of the kindness of the Lord *the* earth is full. R̄.

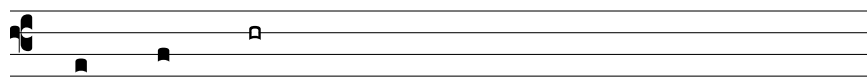


2. See, the eyes of the LORD are upon those who fear

to deliver them from death and preserve them in *spite*

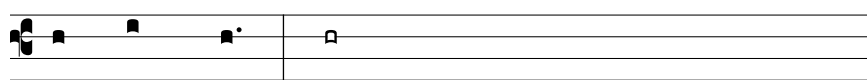




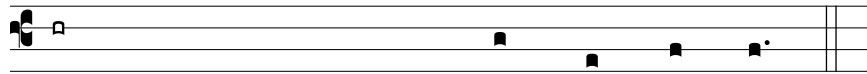
