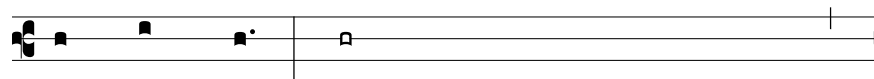
*safe-ty*, for you are my rock and my *fort-ress*. O my



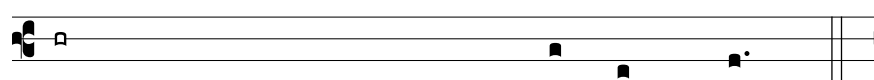

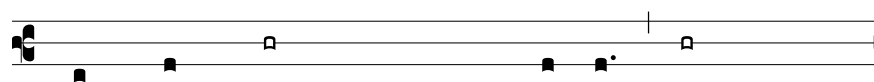
3. For you are my hope, O Lord; my trust, O God,



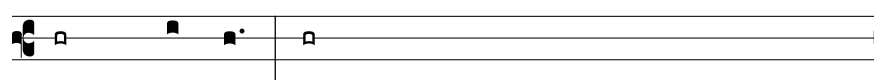
from *my* youth. On you I depend from birth;



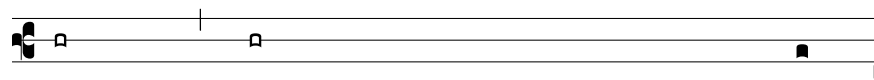
from my mother's womb you *are* my strength. Ṙ.



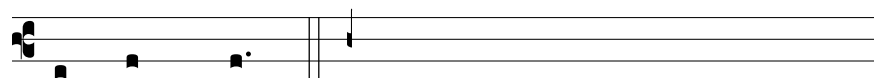
4. My mouth shall declare your *jus-tice*, day by day
