




**T** he just man is a light in darkness to the

1. Light shines through the darkness for the *up*-right;

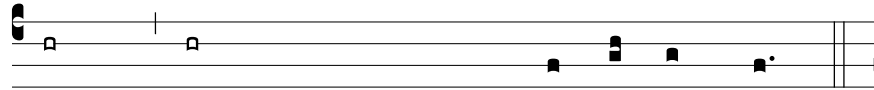

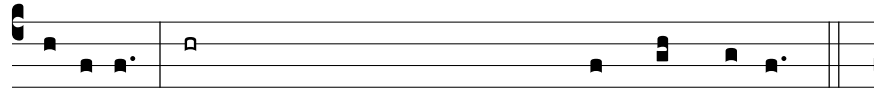
not fear; his heart is firm, trust-*ing* in the LORD. R̄.
