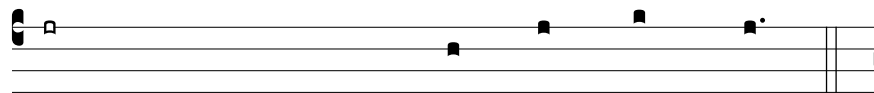
3. Look to him that you may be radiant with joy,



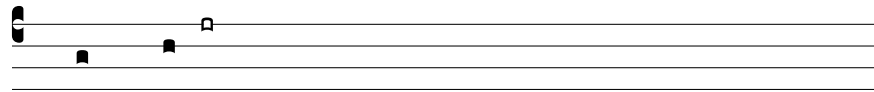
and your faces may not *blush* with shame.



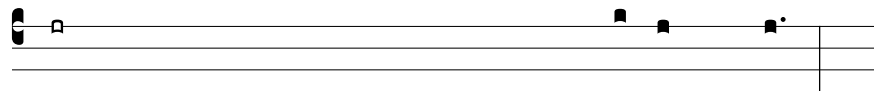

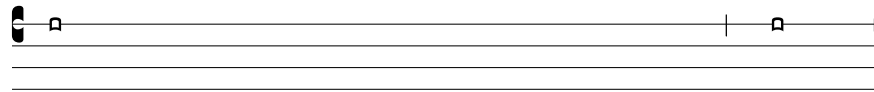

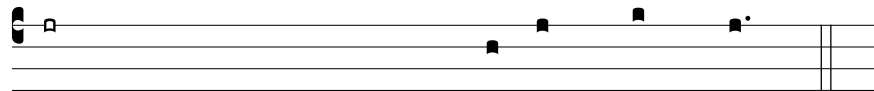
4. The angel of the LORD encamps around
