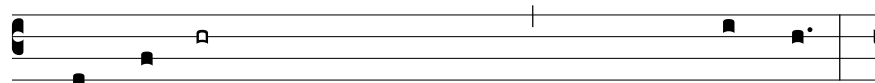

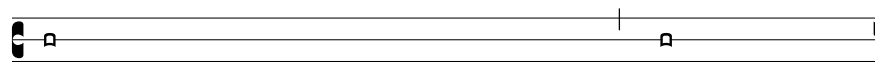

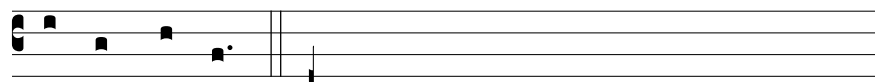
T^V he precepts of the Lord give joy to the heart.



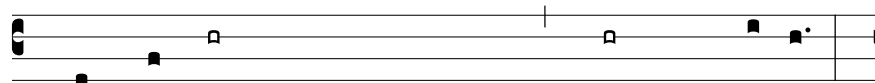
1. The law of the LORD is perfect, refreshing *the* soul;



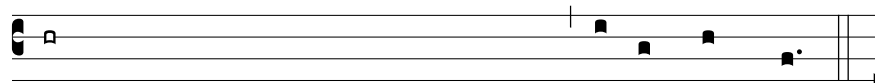
the decree of the LORD is trustworthy, giving wisdom



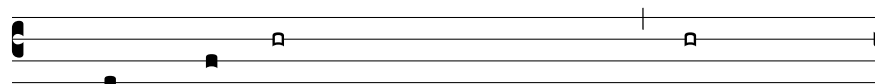

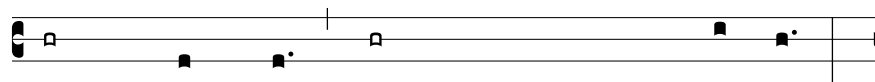
2. The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring *for-ev-er*;



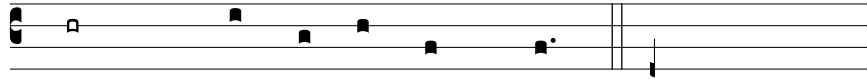
the ordinances of the LORD are true, *all* of them just. *R.*



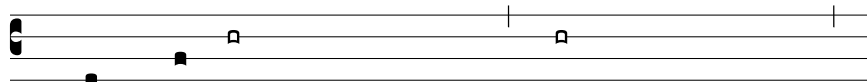
3. Though your servant is careful of them, very diligent



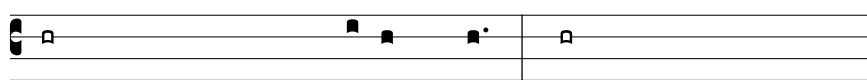
in keep-*ing* them, yet who can detect *fail-ings*?
