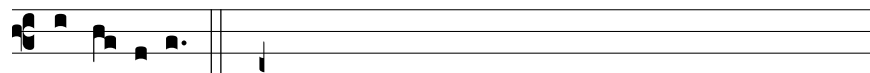

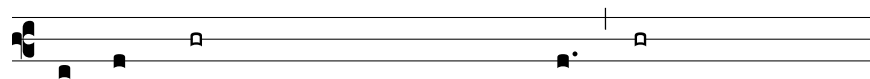

T he vineyard of the Lord is the house



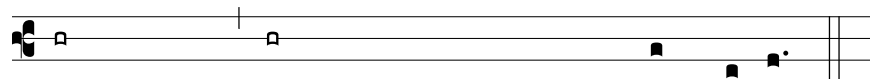

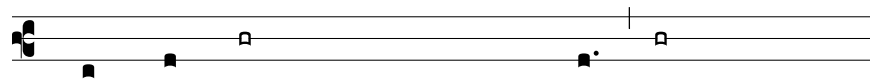
1. A vine from Egypt you transplant-*ed*; you drove away



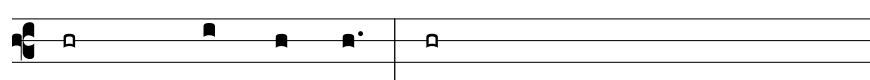
the nations and *plan*-ted it. It put forth its foliage



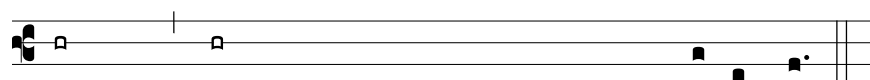
to the Sea, its shoots as far as *the* River. R_z.



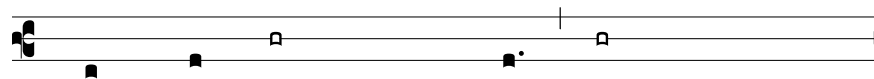
2. Why have you broken down its *walls*, so that every



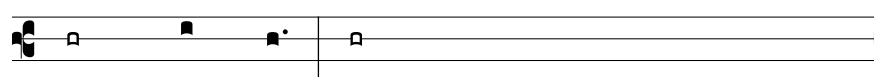
passer-by *plucks* its fruit, the boar from the forest lays



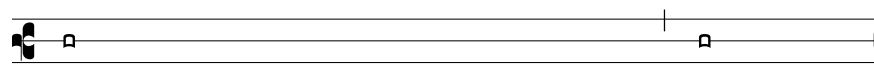
it waste, and the beasts of the field feed *up*-on it? R_z.



3. Once again, O LORD of *hosts*, look down from



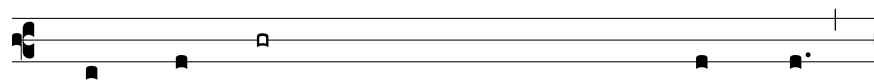
heaven, *and* see; take care of this vine, and



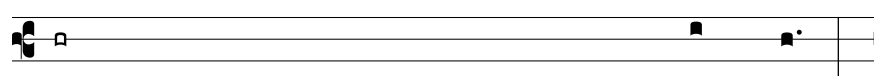
protect what your right hand has planted, the son of



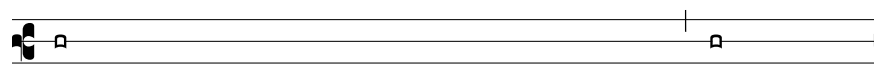
man whom you *your-self* made strong. *R.*



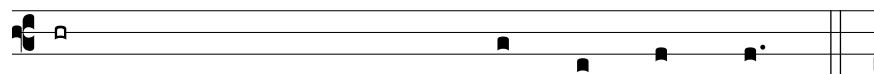
4. Then we will no more withdraw *from* you;
